## ALBURNETT ARCHERY

### NASP

The Alburnett Archery team capped off a great season with a third place high School team finish at the State National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) tournament for the second year in a row. Throughout the months of January and February the team competed in six local invitational tournaments And placed first or second in each. This led up to the all important State NASP tournament which determines who is eligible to attend the National tournament in May. The team scored an impressive 3262, the highest score they had achieved so far this year, which is more than enough to earn a berth to Nationals. In the 6 years that Iowa has held the NASP tournament, including the first year which was an exhibition event only, Alburnett has sent archers to the National tournament. The team also competes as individuals in their respective division, High school, Middle school and Elementary. Individuals awards were presented to the following for their scores at the state tournament. Tymbrie Snobl placed first and Adri Miene placed fifth for High School girls. Zack Bisinger placed fifth for high school boys and Austin Heft placed second for middle school boys.

The National Archery in t school program (NASP) is a joint venture between State Departments of Education and Wildlife. The program promotes student education and participation in the lifelong sport of Archery. The programs focus is to provide international style target archery training in physical education classes, for grades 4-12.
