Field to Fork

This summer the Waltonian Archery Club teamed together with the DNR for their first ever Field to Fork program. There were 10 participants comprised of both adult men and women. These participants had very little to no experience with archery and/or hunting. Each member was assigned an experienced volunteer mentor. Throughout the 16 week course the goals of the program were to successfully learn how to accurately shoot their bow, learn hunting fundamentals, set up a stand, track, field dress, and process a deer, and prepare the venison.

The members had many guest speakers to educate and demonstrate the course goals.

The success of these new archers was largely due to a handful of Waltonian members and mentors who stepped up to help, along with the great facility the Waltonian's club has readily available.
